Bus

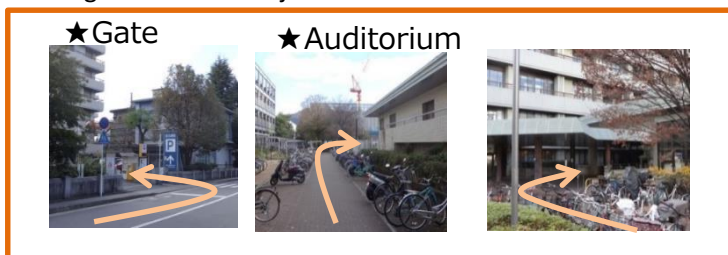
30-40min.

Take city bus **206** [bound for "Kitaoji-Bus Terminal Higashiyama St."] from bus **terminal D2** to "Konoedori" bus stop. North entrance of hospital is approximately 1 min walk to west along Konoe Street from the bus stop.

Enter the gate on the south side of Konoe St., little walk down, turn left, walk a little through cycling parking area, turn right, then you can see two gates.

Select the right one, entrance of Clinical Auditorium.

The registration desk is just behind the entrance.

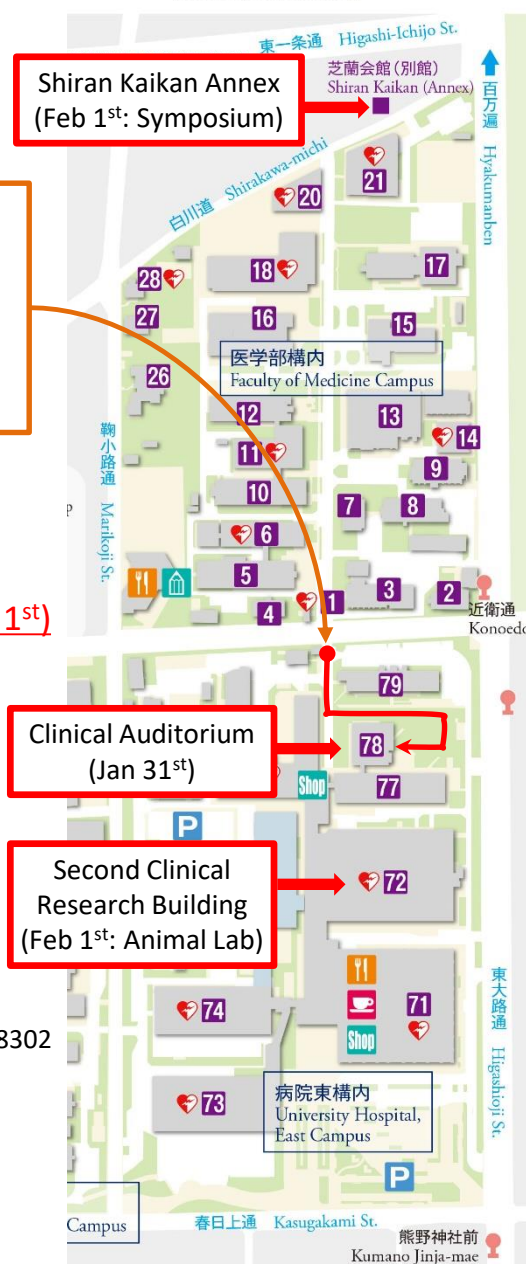

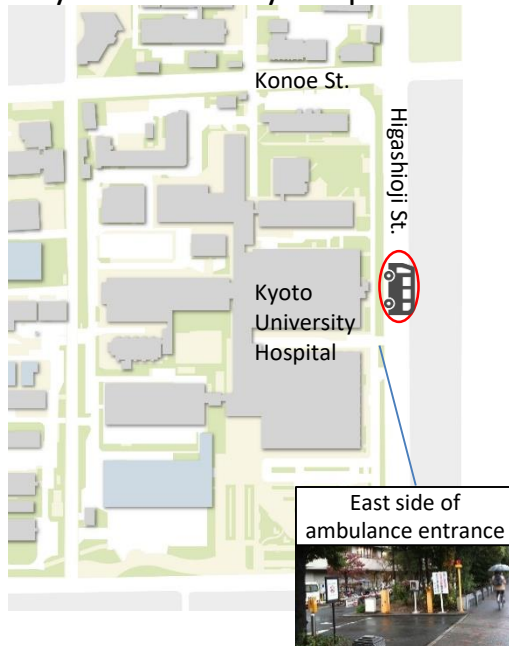

Fusion of Opera and Phonosurgery

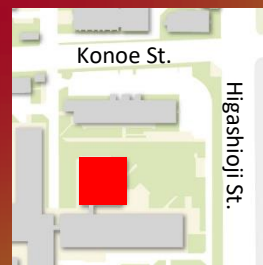
